

2018-2019 Educators Rising Missouri Competitive Events

Missouri competitions will use the same guidelines and scoring rubrics as the national competitions. Competition guidelines and rubrics are available for download at www.educatorsrising.org, under Get Active in the Virtual Campus. Submission dates and methods are different, and Missouri competitions will be open to spectators. Those who plan to enter a Missouri competition must submit an **intent to compete by Feb. 6, 2019** at <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/2019EdRisingIntent>, or the teacher may email the list of names and competitions to Roxane.Bly@mnea.org. Individual students may enter up to a total of two (2) competitions. Chapter competitions count as one (1) competition for the students on the presentation team. Teacher leaders may enter up to **two students per school in each individual event and one team for chapter competitions.** All chapter competitions must have at least two students and no more than four students on the presentation team.
